## Fr Jim's Jottings

**The target audience:** We've had a remarkable response to the offer of the Spiritual Exercises, with all three age groups now full, and limited spaces available at the time of writing only in the two special groups for parents of young children, and young adults (18-30). Why have special groups reserved for these age groups? Because if you look around our parish and indeed any Catholic parish, you'll see that these are the groups which are most under-represented. These are key decision making times in people's lives when the Church should be most actively involved in ministering to people, but because of their busyness we often don't get to reach them. Only churches which intentionally focus on younger people ever reach them. And it is by being intentional in reaching out to engage with younger people that churches grow.

So if you're 18-30, or you have children 0-5 or in primary school and would like to take part in the Spiritual Exercises in the coming weeks, contact [jim@chatswoodparish.org.au](mailto:jim@chatswoodparish.org.au). For others, my apologies that our groups are already full, however we'll likely run this program again due to such high demand. Meanwhile, look out for our other faith formation opportunities such as the Broken Bay Bible Conference July 27-28 (see [www.dbb.org.au](http://www.dbb.org.au)) and Alpha also starting in July.

**A celebration - Anniversaries:** Next weekend we are celebrating significant anniversaries of ordination for two of our clergy: Fr John Puliparambil celebrates 20 years as a priest, and Deacon Kevin Hale celebrates 10 years as a deacon. Join with them in celebrating at the Mass 10.30am Sunday April 15<sup>th</sup> and a light lunch which will follow (please bring a plate to share).

**Men:** We sometimes feel like we're the only ones who struggle with marriage, parenting, career, health, and faith. We tend to be less verbal and vocal than women. We often struggle to articulate what's going in our hearts. But when there's a safe space to be quiet or to speak, we can often find a voice to speak our desires to be the best husbands, fathers, friends and men we can be. For the past year a group of men from our parish aged 21-70 have gathered for an opportunity to talk together as Catholic men about the things which matter in our lives as they did at the Men Alive Weekend. Now they want to join other men to join with them and Fr Jim, starting with a "Men's Mass" on 7pm this Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> April. ## Within the Parish

### SCHOOL ENROLMENT

Local Catholic schools are beginning their school enrolment processes and asking for a parish reference. For Our Lady of Dolours Primary School you will be asked to sign up for a one hour workshop with Fr Jim and Gail Gill when you sign up for an interview with the school principal. For other Catholic primary schools, contact the parish office on 9410 9000 to also join one of these workshops. For high schools, download the Parish Reference Form from

[www.chatswoodparish.org.au](http://www.chatswoodparish.org.au), complete your section of the clergy school reference form and send to Fr Jim via mail or the parish office. We will then use objective measures such as involvement in parish ministries, rosters, and commitment to planned giving to verify a family's church involvement. No interview will usually be needed, though Fr Jim may need to call if he can't verify you from other means. A tip: be honest on your self-evaluation. Better a modest claim which is verified by the parish priest than an exaggerated claim which is contradicted by the parish priest.

### RETURN OF PROJECT COMPASSION BOXES AND ENVELOPES

Just a reminder to return your Project Compassion boxes by placing them in the basket on the offertory table which will be brought to the altar during the offertory procession, or drop into the Parish Office during the week. This year we are asking people to please count up the amount in their Project Compassion box and write the amount raised on the box and tick whether you require a receipt or not. **And thanks too for remembering your Project Compassion envelopes: they may be put on the collections at any Mass or left at the Parish Office.**

### DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY DEVOTION

The Feast of Divine Mercy is celebrated on the Sunday following Easter Sunday expressing the association between the two feasts. Easter marks the salvation won by Jesus' atoning sacrifice on the cross and His victory over death. The Feast of Divine Mercy celebrates God's loving forgiveness to all who have sinned.



On Divine Mercy Sunday 8 April, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at 2pm. The first hour will be for quiet adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and veneration of the Divine Mercy image followed by devotional prayers, homily, blessing of Divine Mercy images and concludes with Benediction at around 4pm. Reconciliation is available from 2-3pm.

**Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay**

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry.
