This year's theme is "beat plastic pollution". Many of you will be aware of Sophia's petition calling for a ban on single-use and heavy retail plastic bags. Sophia is a student at Monte' Sant Angelo and inspired by Pope Francis's encyclical Laudato Si she is seeking community support for this ban. We are asking you to sign Sophia's petition that asks the Legislative Assembly to introduce legislation to stop the use of single-use plastic bags at retail points of sale in NSW. Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012*.
