You will receive only one weekly email, and you'll have the option to unsubscribe at the bottom of each email. You can also download the app by searching "church enews" in the Play Store or iTunes, selecting "Church ENews Experts", and then entering "Chatswood" to select our parish. You'll get alerts for each new church newsletter, and the archive of previous bulletins will be available also. We hope this will both improve parishioner's access to parish information, and in time reduce our reliance on printed paper.

CWF NEXT WEEKEND 4/5 AUGUST

Thank you to our compassionate and generous parishioners for supporting the Charitable Works Fund. Thanks to you our Parish almost reached its target of \$47,078.00 in the last financial year.

The Charitable Works Fund is 100% tax deductible and 98.25 cents of every dollar goes to the following five beneficiaries:

- **Confraternity of Christian Doctrine** – creating and updating the curriculum and training catechists who minister to public school students across the Diocese.
- **St Lucy's School** – for primary school students with disabilities.
- **St Edmund's School** – for secondary school students with disabilities.
- **Ephpheta Centre** – serving the Catholic deaf community.

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012*.
